

an application on the grounds that there are already enough shops/traders in an area can no longer be used. Legal advice obtained in January 2021 confirms that the Provision of Services Regulations, which were introduced in 2009 and implemented the EUSD into UK law, continue to apply in the context of Licensing including street trading.

Should you have any comments, please let me know by 26 May 2021. If I do not hear from you by this date, I shall assume you have no objection.

With the current situation we are trying to process street trading applications quicker in order to 'Help Business' but if you need a longer consultation period, please let me know urgently.

Should valid objections be received in relation to the application, these will be notified to the applicant and the application may be referred to the Council's Street Trading Sub-Committee for a decision. The applicant and objectors will be invited to take part in any meeting.
