Each garden will be judged on its merits, whether large or small, the judge's decision being final
(All allotments are automatically entered into the competition)

CLASS 1 - BEST KEPT GARDEN – Under 50m²
(At the discretion of the City Council) Front/Rear

CLASS 2 - BEST KEPT GARDEN – Over 50m²
(At the discretion of the City Council) Front/Rear

CLASS 3 - BEST KEPT PATIO GARDEN
Paved garden with collection of tubs/containers or hanging baskets

CLASS 4 - BEST HANGING BASKET OR WINDOW BOX DISPLAY
Business or Private (Any Number)

CLASS 5 - BEST BUSINESS FRONTAGE – e.g. Office/Shop Premises/Guest House

CLASS 6 - BEST KEPT COMMUNAL GARDEN
e.g. Nursing Home, Private, Local Authority Owned or voluntary group

CLASS 7 - BEST KEPT VEGETABLE GARDEN

CLASS 8 - BEST KEPT GARDEN ATTENDED BY THE DISABLED

CLASS 9 - BEST KEPT AREA MAINTAINED BY CHILDREN

CLASS 10 - BEST KEPT SCHOOL GARDEN
e.g. pre-school, primary or secondary school

CLASS 11 - BEST WILDLIFE-FRIENDLY GARDEN

CLASS 12 - BEST POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY GARDEN

CLASS 13 - BEST GREEN INITIATIVE - e.g. eco-friendly, environmentally friendly

CLASS 14 - BEST WATER GARDEN

CLASS 15 - BEST URBAN GARDEN
